



Temporary local rules | Specified circumstances

December 6th, 2024

These local rules only apply under these specified circumstances.

Area for grazing sheep

This local rule only applies when an area is surrounded by an electric fence.

The areas surrounded by electric fencing to contain the grazing sheep (with or without sheep) are abnormal course areas defined as **no play zones**. The boundary of these no play zones is one clublength from the fence. When there is interference from these areas, free relief must be taken according to Rule 16.1f.

Code of conduct

It is strictly forbidden to enter this no play zone. Penalty for a breach of this rule

- **General penalty for competitions**
- **The board decides on any disciplinary measures**

Preferred lies (local rule E-3)

Preferred lies only apply when when “Plaatsen” has been announced on the website and/or on the information board near the first tee.

When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from this relief area:

- Reference Point: Spot of the original ball.
- Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: the length of a scorecard (15 cm) from the reference point, but with these limits:
 - Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and
 - Must be in the general area.

In proceeding under this Local Rule, the player must choose a spot to place the ball and use the procedures for replacing a ball under Rules 14.2b(2) and 14.2e.

Penalty for playing a ball from a wrong place in breach of a local rule: general penalty under rule 14.7a.
